3	Total # of patients in which a validated instrument was used to determine the current level of asthma control with each level of control	
4	Total # of patients well controlled	
	4a. Total # of patients not well controlled	
	4b. Total # of # of patients very poorly controlled	
	4c. Total # of patients who are "not well controlled" or "very poorly controlled" with a reason for lack of control	
5	Total # of patients with spirometry currently scheduled to be tested, or results have been obtained within the last 1 or 2 years	
	5a. Total # of those patients younger than 5 years	
6	Total # of patients where age-appropriate NHLBI EPR-3 stepwise table was used to identify treatment options or to adjust therapy based on asthma control	
7	Total # of patients that have been administered a flu shot or a recommendation was made within the last 12 months	
	7a. Total # of patients younger than 6 mos, other contraindications, or vaccine unavailable	
8	Total # of patients with a written Asthma Action Plan that was updated as needed and reviewed with the patient and/or family at this visit	
9	Total # of patients with asthma self-management education and materials (other than or in addition to the asthma action plan) provided and explained to the patient and family at any visit	
10	Total # of patients with a follow-up appointment recommended to monitor asthma control
