

## Track: Emergency Department

**Directions:** Use this tool for the next 20 charts of patients age < 24 completed months, with a primary diagnosis of bronchiolitis, discharged from the ED as well as patients admitted to the hospital inpatient ward from the ED.

**Exclusion:**

- Born at < 35 completed weeks of gestation
- Hemodynamically significant congenital heart disease (for example, you may not need to exclude isolated ASD or VSD if patient on no cardiac medications)
- Bronchopulmonary dysplasia or chronic lung disease
- Other genetic, congenital, chromosomal or neuromuscular abnormality that is felt by chart reviewer to significantly complicate the respiratory illness
- Admitted to the PICU from the ED or receive any PICU care at any point during admission.

**NOTE:** EQIPP does not record any patient identifying information. You may enter it here for your own record-keeping purposes.
