

EQIPP: Talking About Serious Illness

Instructions: Pull 1 chart of patients identified in your care that may benefit from a serious illness conversation and prepare to answer the following questions.

[Definition: Serious illness is a health condition that carries a high risk of mortality AND either negatively impact's a person daily function or quality of life, OR excessively strains their caregivers.]

[Please Note: The purpose of this QI activity is to help build physician skills and awareness in preparing, conducting, and documenting serious illness conversations. Unlike traditional EQIPP courses with a retrospective review of charts, this activity employs a prospective view. The goal for this module is to conduct 3 intentional goals of care conversations with patients and families identified as having Serious Illnesses]
